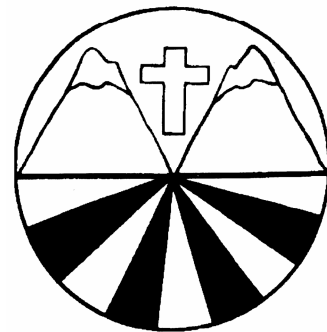

VOTE for the next premier of our province. Voting takes place at West Central High School on Saturday, December 2, from 9 a.m. to 7 p.m.

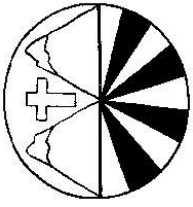

VOLUNTEER DRIVERS

In September the Board implemented new volunteer driver requirements. However after making this change, there appeared to be a decrease in the number of drivers who signed on. As a Christian School family we encourage parents and grandparents to become involved in school activities such as field trips and after school sports. Being a volunteer gives us the opportunity to meet parents and students and develop friendship and camaraderie. Rocky Christian School needs to adhere to current insurance requirements, but we do not want to make the volunteer driver requirements too onerous. Therefore after reviewing our insurance policies and other school policies, the volunteer driver requirements will now be:

- \$2 million liability insurance
- Current (within 12 months) Drivers Abstract with no more than 6 demerit points
- Minimum age of 21 years

A Criminal Records Check will no longer be required, and Rocky Christian School will reimburse drivers for the cost of the Driver's Abstract if requested. Please consider signing up as a volunteer driver. The new form will be sent home soon.



