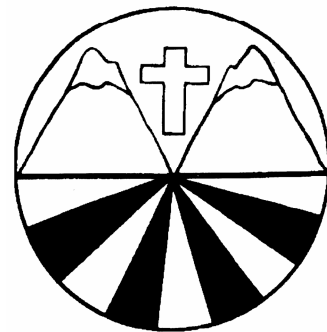

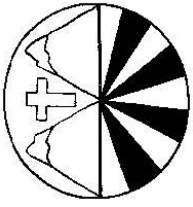
RCS T-SHIRTS can be purchased at the office for \$12 each.

GARBAGE PICKUP – *Saturday, May 6* – Meet at 9:00 a.m. at the First Christian Reformed Church.

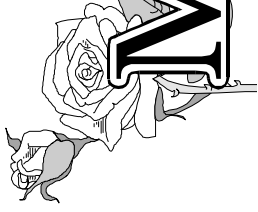
GRADE EIGHT PARENTS – Phone the office to sign up to help with the grad supper on June 2.
